Rules and Guidelines

Basics:

All entries must be original works of the artist and cannot have been previously exhibited in the Morini Gallery during the past three years.

Drop off hours are 10:30 a.m. to 4 p.m., except by prior arrangement. See the show description for drop-off dates

Fees & Commissions

There is a non-refundable hanging fee for each entry

The Morini Gallery retains a commission for all artwork sold.

Commissions go to MMAS and are considered a tax-deductible donation.

Framing:

All entries must have artist's name, phone number and title of piece on the back.

All entries must be appropriately framed and frames must be in good condition.

Unframed canvases, if allowed, must be museum wrapped with painted edges.

All entries must be stoutly wired without excess wire. Wire must be placed approximately 1/3 of the way down from the top of the piece.

Saw tooth hangers are not accepted.

Release and Responsibilities:

All entries accepted for hanging will be eligible for publication in MMAS promotional materials and press releases. And while MMAS handles all art pieces with care, the artist understands that MMAS cannot be held responsible for loss or damage.
